We recognise in full our responsibilities in respect of environmental protection and accept that it should constitute a fundamental element in company procedures and long-term strategy.

On-Set Location Limited will comply with all existing environmental legislation and, beyond that; where possible and practicable, will implement other environmentally advantageous policies. In particular, the company will:

- Control, monitor and reduce the fuel consumption and emission levels of all vehicles, encouraging greater fuel economy, so reducing emission levels.
- Take account of environmental considerations such as developments in fuel and vehicle technology, when acquiring new company vehicles.
- Regularly maintain and service all company vehicles to ensure their efficiency and minimise GHG emissions.
- Ensure that vehicle weights remain within legal restrictions, limiting damage to highways and the environment.
- Actively consider noise reduction devices for both vehicles and trailers.
- We educate our staff on what everyone can do to help the environment. Also offering staff training through BAFTA Albert's free training scheme.
- We will use, where viable, recyclable products and encourage the recycling of materials and waste. Actively monitoring both recycling rates and waste levels.
- Where applicable, liaise closely with statutory and local authorities, clients, third party organisations and the public.
- Implement new systems of work to reduce paper usage.
- Endeavour to collect data on our Carbon Footprint and utilise approved schemes as well as local tree planting to offset our footprint in order to become a carbon neutral supplier.
- Place sustainability on the agenda of management meetings and internal communications to staff.
- Monitor our energy consumption quarterly and set reduction targets.
